One day, squirrel Karamel came to Grandpa Mahmut's field. He was very excited when he saw the corn in the field. He started gnawing the corn.


Grandpa Mahmut saw the squirrel. He started chasing him. Shouting:

-Stay away from my corn, he said. Squirrel Caramel quickly ran away.




The next day he came back to the field and started eating the corn. Grandpa Mahmut decided to talk to the squirrel. Sadly:
